

RT. HON. HERB GRAY PARKWAY TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE HIGHWAY 3 EASTBOUND AND LABELLE STREET

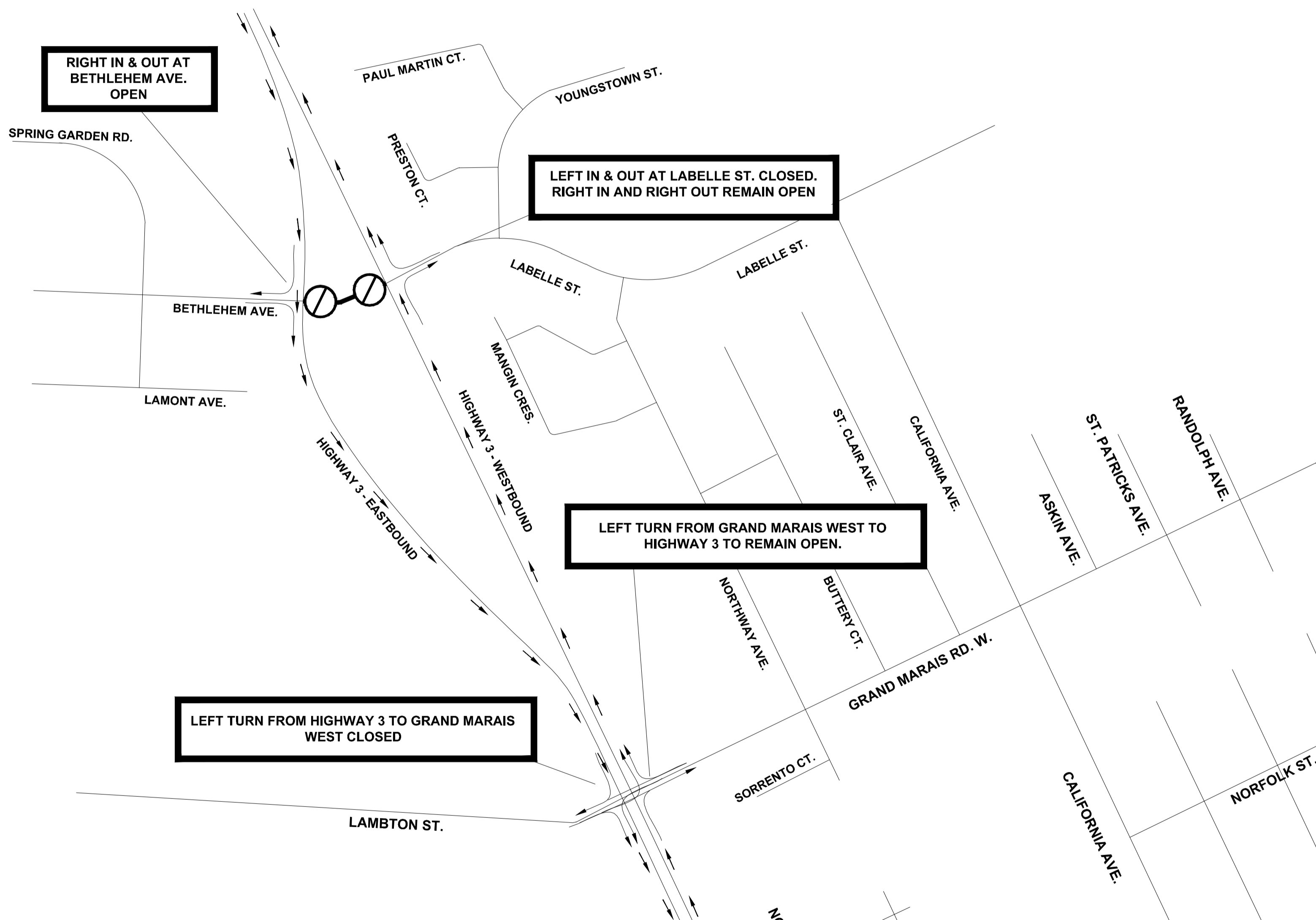
As part of construction of the Rt. Hon. Herb Gray Parkway, temporary lane closures are required at Highway 3 eastbound between E.C. Row Expressway and Lambton Road/Grand Marais Road West. Weather permitting, the closures will begin after 6:00 p.m. on Friday, December 12, 2014, and are anticipated to be in effect for a minimum of two months.

The closures are as follows:

- left-hand turn lane from Highway 3 eastbound to Grand Marais Road West
- left-hand turn lane from Highway 3 eastbound to Labelle Street
- left-hand turn lane from Labelle Street to Highway 3 eastbound.

Left-hand turns will not be permitted where these lanes are closed.

Additionally, a permanent portion of Highway 3 eastbound between E.C. Row Expressway and the Lambton Road/Grand Marais Road West intersection will open to traffic and the new Bethlehem Avenue intersection over the Labelle Tunnel (T-2) will open for right-turn access only from and to Highway 3 eastbound.



We appreciate your cooperation during this time. All closures are scheduled pending weather conditions.
