- Regular meetings for municipal staff, agencies, WIFN and the public have been and will be held throughout the project.

To date over 3500 people have attended our seven PIOH, neighbourhood meetings, and landscape workshops. In addition, the Windsor Essex Mobility Group's Public Liaison Office has had over 2800 interactions with the community via meetings, emails and phone calls.

We listened to your input and it has influenced many facets of the Parkway, including:

- Installation and maintenance of four additional signalized intersections:
 - o Pulford Street and Highway 3, providing a connection to the multi-use trail
 - o Howard Avenue Connector and County 9 (Howard Avenue Diversion), providing a connection to the multi-use trail from the Commuter Parking Lot
 - o Heritage Drive and Sandwich West Parkway
 - o South Talbot Road and Walker Road

- Addition of 18 trail connections to improve access to municipal trails and facilities
- Inclusion of seven shaded rest areas along the multi-use trail system
- Addition of two street lights on Homestead Lane
- Upgrades to utility design and installation
- LED lighting has been incorporated into each tunnel and along the multi-use trail system
- Enhancement to the pedestrian bridge design
- Addition of screening and landscaped berms along the project
- Review of Power Distribution Assembly (PDA) and pump station locations to reduce visibility
- Review of landscape treatment adjacent to specific communities

- Enhancement to four sidewalks to improve community connections, including:
 - o Extension of sidewalk along the west side of Sandwich West Parkway from Highway 3 to Heritage Drive
 - o Extension of sidewalk along the south/east side of Todd Lane from multi-use trail to Tenth Street
 - o Upgrade currently designed sidewalk on south side of Bethlehem Avenue to secondary trail system
 - o Addition of sidewalk on the west side of Grand Marais Road West from Highway 3 northerly to south side of the driveway for Academie Ste. Cecile

- Review of noise barrier locations
- Incorporation of First Nations theme and consideration for future public art
- Advancement of landscaping and noise barrier installation where feasible
- Enhancement to signage and increased emergency call station locations
- Modifications to the eco-passage, maximizing opportunities to re-establish the area's ecological connectivity
- Enhancements to the protection of species at risk, plants and animals
- Improvements to construction mitigation measures and maintenance processes.

Thank you for your ongoing interest and support. All comments and input received are provided to the project team for consideration, and are included in each applicable Design and Construction Report.
