**RE: RT. HON. HERB GRAY PARKWAY ENVIRONMENTAL WORKS IN NORTHWAY NEIGHBOURHOOD.**

As part of the construction of the Rt. Hon. Herb Gray Parkway, the Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO), the Windsor Essex Mobility Group (WEMG), and Parkway Infrastructure Constructors (PIC) are writing to advise you that plant removals located on MTO-owned property in your area will begin within the next two weeks. The process to remove these plants is expected to take approximately two-to-three weeks. This work was previously communicated to you through a letter and invitation to a meeting held in June 2013 on-site with MTO staff and plant biologists.

Transplanting activities will involve hand removal of plants using spades/shovels and may also require the use of a bobcat. Temporary fencing will be erected around the entire site while work is underway. The contractor – Danshab – is required to control dust, limit mud-tracking, and do a daily clean-up of the work site and access road. The work will take place during daytime hours and you may see additional vehicles parking on the street during the period of the work.

The lot will be graded and seeded immediately after transplant. MTO will maintain the lot and will consider selling it in the future for residential use. If you have any concerns with the maintenance of this property, please contact MTO's Windsor office at 519-973-7367.
