


## Temporary Closure of Howard Avenue north of Highway 3

Beginning Friday, June 6, 2014, at approximately 7 p.m., Howard Avenue north of Highway 3 will be closed for approximately one month. This closure is required to complete reconstruction of the intersection of Howard Avenue and Highway 3 as part of the Rt. Hon. Herb Gray Parkway (the Parkway). The closure is limited to the area directly north of the Highway 3 intersection and does not impact local residents accessing homes on Howard Avenue north of Highway 3. Local traffic accessing the Southwood Lakes subdivision is also able to travel via Howard Avenue to Havens Drive.

Southbound traffic will be detoured at North Talbot Road, over Highway 401 to Walker Road and south to Highway 3. Traffic may also detour via Walker Road or Highway 401. All detours will bring traffic into the Parkway roundabout that connects County Road 9, Howard Avenue (south), Highway 3, and Highway 401. At the time of this closure, the fourth leg of the roundabout will be open to Highway 401 traffic. Highway 3 west of Highway 401 remains open through both closures. Please review the Rt. Hon. Howard Avenue south of Highway 3 is currently closed to complete construction of Bridge 12 (Howard Avenue) that will carry traffic over the below-grade Parkway. This closure began in October 2013 and is expected to be completed in summer 2014.
