**Re: Rt. Hon. Herb Gray Parkway Restoration Areas Spring 2015 Brush Cutting**

Dear Resident,

In September 2014, representatives from the Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) and Parkway Infrastructure Constructors (PIC) met with local residents regarding illegal motorized vehicle access (ATVs) in the MTO ecological restoration areas in the vicinity of Chappus Street. At that time, residents were informed of the Ministry's intent to install a fence to protect these ecologically sensitive areas in 2015.

Letters were delivered on February 9, 2015, to area residents regarding surveying work being carried out in the area to determine fence configuration. Information regarding the fence configuration was presented at a community drop-in session on March 9, 2015.

It has been determined that some brush and limited tree removal is required to accommodate the fence.

Beginning the **week of March 23 and continuing until the week of March 30**, contractors working on behalf of MTO will start brush and tree removal. All work is limited to MTO and City of Windsor property. A project biologist will be on hand to supervise this work and ensure that any environmental impacts are minimized. All work will be conducted in accordance with City of Windsor noise by-laws.
