

Highway 3 Roundabout

As part of the Howard Avenue Diversion, a two-lane roundabout will be constructed at the intersection of the realigned Highway 3, the future Howard Avenue Diversion and the Parkway on/off ramps.

What is being constructed?

The roundabout will be of a size to accommodate large trucks and will facilitate smooth movement of traffic through this area. The centre of the roundabout will be landscaped. Details on the landscaping for the roundabout will be presented to the public for feedback at a future Public Information Open House.

The roundabout will be one of the first features constructed for the Windsor-Essex Parkway to facilitate traffic staging operations.



Potential Effects	Proposed Mitigation
Vegetation removal and grading.	Species at risk are being transplanted and site will be landscaped at the completion of construction.
Noise and dust disruption during construction.	For noise and dust mitigation, please refer to the "Construction Mitigation" fact sheet.
Drivers unaccustomed to roundabouts operations may initially find the intersection difficult to navigate.	Campaign will be launched to provide the community information on how to safely navigate the roundabout.
