As part of the Windsor-Essex Parkway, a multi-lane roundabout will soon open to traffic where the Howard Avenue Diversion meets Highway 3, Highway 401 and Howard Avenue (County Road 9).

As this roundabout is located at a key intersection, the Ministry of Transportation, with support from the Windsor Essex Mobility Group and Parkway Infrastructure Constructors, is hosting a Roundabout Public Education Centre. At this meeting, the Windsor-Essex Parkway project team and engineering consultant staff will provide information on the operation of roundabouts, provide guidance for proper usage and answer questions. This is a drop-in style open house, with brief presentations at 4:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

- features and benefits of the roundabout
- how to enter and exit the Parkway roundabout
- proper signalization
- what to do when you encounter an emergency vehicle in a roundabout
- signage.

At the Education Centre, Construction Managers, Traffic Managers, technical staff and representatives from the Ministry of Transportation will be on hand to answer questions.
