

Information for Windsor Crossing Tenants August 28, 2012

Since the Windsor-Essex Parkway construction started in August 2011, the Windsor Essex Mobility Group (WEMG) and Parkway Infrastructure Constructors (PIC) have been working on an aggressive schedule. To minimize the length of time that the Parkway takes to complete, construction will be ongoing simultaneously throughout the project area. We want to work as quickly as possible to complete construction so that residents and travellers can start realizing the Parkway's many benefits.

There will be ongoing construction works throughout several sections of the project footprint. Over the next six months, the following main construction activities can be expected in the area surrounding Windsor Crossing from Outer Drive to Cabana Road West:

- road construction between Bridge 10 (west of St. Clair College) to Sandwich West Parkway
- road construction between Bridge 10 to Cabana Road
- road construction between Cousineau Road to Montgomery Drive
- road construction between Howard Avenue to existing Highway 3, east of Outer Drive
- construction of new Highway 3 in the area between east of Howard Avenue to the intersection with existing Highway 3
- Highway 401 reconstruction from Howard Avenue to North Talbot Road
- Bridge 9 (between Cabana Road West and Geraedts Drive) construction
- Bridge 10 (west of St. Clair College) construction
- Bridge 11 (west of Howard Avenue) construction.

Temporary Diversion for Sandwich West Parkway (Diversion D-14)

Diversion D-14 will be open for the construction of the Cousineau Tunnel (T-9) tunnel. It is anticipated that it will be opened in October 2012 for about six weeks. The diversion will include a signalized intersection. D-14 will allow for continued access from Highway 3 through Sandwich West Parkway, maintaining the existing entrances to Windsor Crossing. The map to the right illustrates the future diversion.

Temporary Closure of Cousineau Road at Highway 3

Starting in November 2012, Cousineau Road will be closed at its intersection with Highway 3 for a period of 11 months.

This closure is necessary to allow for the construction of the Cousineau Tunnel (T-9). During the closure, the intersection of Highway 3 and Sandwich West Parkway will remain open.

For traffic coming from Cousineau Road to Highway 3 westbound, the detour route will be:

- Cousineau Road to Mount Royal Drive, to Dominion Boulevard, to E.C. Row Expressway westbound, to Huron Church Road.



For traffic coming from Highway 3 to Cousineau Road, the detour route will be:

- Highway 3 to Howard Avenue northbound, to Country Club Drive, to Cousineau Road.

Notification of Traffic Impacts

Advanced signage will be installed seven to 14 days prior to the opening of D-14 and prior to the closure of Cousineau and will be positioned in strategic locations in relation to the traffic flow. Residents will be made aware via direct mail drop. Public notices will appear in local newspapers and all information will be available on the project web and social media sites.
