As this roundabout is located at a key intersection, the Ministry of Transportation, with support from the Windsor Essex Mobility Group and Parkway Infrastructure Constructors, is hosting a second Roundabout Public Education Centre. The first session was held on October 4, 2012. At this meeting, the Parkway project team will provide information on the operation of roundabouts, guidance for proper usage and answer questions. This is a drop-in style open house, with brief presentations at 4:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
