

Three area-specific Neighbourhood Meetings are being hosted by the Parkway Infrastructure Constructors (PIC) during the month of June. The purpose of the meetings is, on a neighbourhood basis, to review and receive input on specific details pertaining to landscaping, noise barriers, trails, walls, pump stations, Power Distribution Assemblies and transformers. An update on construction activities over the next six months will also be provided. A complete list of the landscaping and related topics is presented below.

These Neighbourhood Meetings are being held at the **Macedonian Community Centre** at 5225 Howard Avenue and are organized based on geographic locations as follows:

Cabana Road to Ojibway Parkway	Tuesday, June 12, 2012, 6:00 p.m.
Outer Drive to Geraedts Drive	Wednesday, June 13, 2012, 6:00 p.m.
Geraedts Drive to Cabana Road	Wednesday, June 20, 2012, 6:00 p.m.

Please get involved and have your say on the final landscape design for the Windsor-Essex Parkway. If you are unable to attend the meeting on the scheduled evening for your neighbourhood, it may be beneficial to attend one of the other meetings. Although the discussion will be focussed on a particular geographic area, there will be general information available along with the opportunity to speak to project team members. Information presented and feedback collected will be presented at a future Public Information Open House.

The topics to be discussed with those in attendance include:

- general landscaping philosophy
- a summary of what we have heard from the public about landscaping to date
- plant material type and rationale for selections
- treatment on tunnel tops
- noise barriers including walls and berms, the location of each and the look of each
- property boundary fencing, permanent snake fence and security fencing
- trails including trail bridges and tunnels, lighting and signage, pedestrian bridge aesthetics and look
- retaining walls, bridge walls, parapet walls and wing walls including locations of the and aesthetic treatment
- locations of transformers, aesthetics and screens of Power Distribution Assemblies and cabinets
- location and look of pump stations
- any other features about which the residents have questions.

The Neighbourhood Meetings will include a general presentation at the beginning of the meeting followed by round table discussions and exercises with project team members where you will have the opportunity to provide your input on specific landscaping elements of the Parkway.
