**RE: OVERNIGHT CONSTRUCTION WORKS, SHADETREE NEIGHBOURHOOD**

Dear Resident,

The Parkway Infrastructure Constructors would like to apologize for any disruptions that may have been caused by the grinding works that took place last night as part of the construction works for the Windsor-Essex Parkway Diversion D-5, located adjacent to the Shadetree area.

Please be advised that the laying of asphalt will be required as part of the final construction activities required for the completion of the Diversion. This activity requires the closure of one lane which can only occur during night time hours. The asphalt placement will occur tonight after midnight. We would like to assure that the asphalt works taking place tonight will not cause the same levels of disruption as those that may have been experienced as a result of yesterday evenings grinding works. We commit to completing this work as quickly and quietly as possible.

The construction of a temporary noise wall and a temporary berm is underway in order to assist with noise mitigation associated with the future opening of the Diversion and is anticipated to be completed by early next week. The new Diversion road will not be opened until the installation of the temporary noise wall and berm are complete.

We sincerely appreciate your cooperation during this time. All construction activities are scheduled pending weather conditions.
