

Temporary Closure of the Intersection of Howard Avenue, South Talbot Road and Laurier Parkway

Intersection of Howard Avenue and South Talbot Road

The intersection of Howard Avenue and South Talbot Road will be closed for 19 days beginning on Monday, August 13, 2012, at 7:00 a.m. until Friday, August 31, 2012, at approximately 6:00 p.m.

Intersection of Howard Avenue and Laurier Parkway

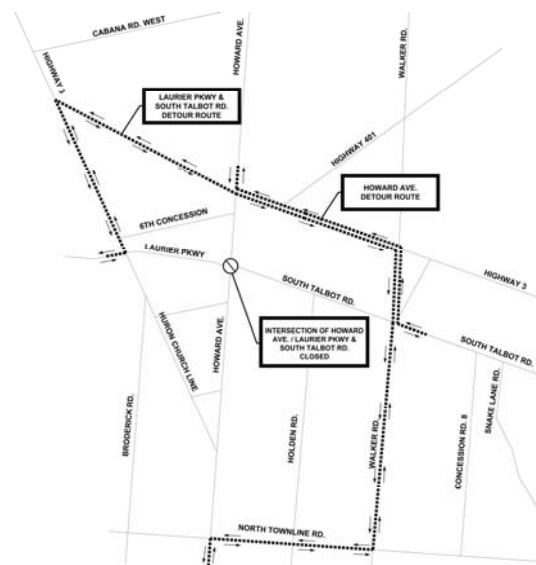
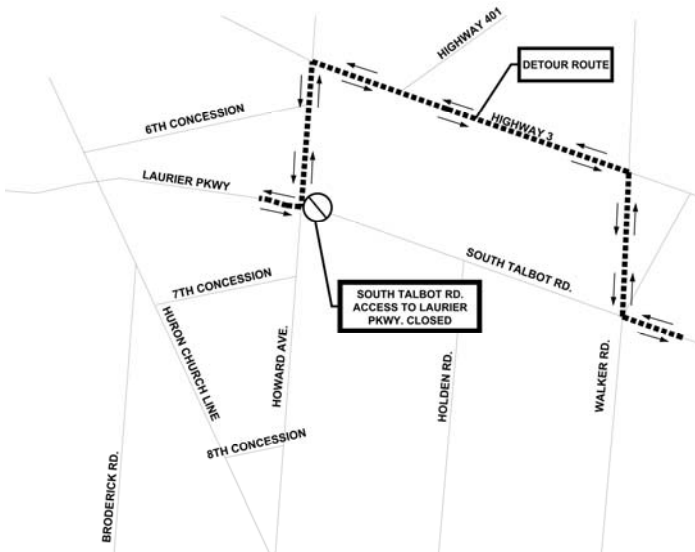
The intersection of Howard Avenue and Laurier Parkway will be closed for 11 days beginning on Monday, August 20, 2012, at 7:00 a.m. until Friday, August 31, 2012, at approximately 6:00 p.m.

These closures are required for the reconstruction of those intersections as a permanent part of the Windsor-Essex Parkway. Throughout the period of these closures, detour routes will be as follows:

- From August 13, 2012, to August 19, 2012, the detour route will follow South Talbot Road to Walker Road to Highway 3 to Howard Avenue to Laurier Parkway.
- From August 20, 2012, to August 31, 2012, the detour route will follow Highway 3 to Walker Road to County Road 8 to Howard Avenue.

Following this work, the intersection will look and function much the same with the exception that Howard Avenue will approach the intersection further to the east than it does currently. The existing Howard Avenue will become a cul-de-sac and the new Howard Avenue will travel southerly from the modern four-lane roundabout.
